
Yes, I know.

Decentralized Project Management with Agile/Scrum

- Emphasis: *Techniques, not Toolset*
- This presentation does not contain step-by-step tutorials, in part because I
 have severe RSI and generating these materials makes my injury worse.
- Essentially, you just need to have a moderator and a regular meeting at a preset times.
- Sprints? Backlog? Burndown List?????
- Be sure to explain your terminology.

Benefits

- Inclusivity:
 - people with disabilities
 - mix of paid staff and volunteers
 - can also include students and researchers

- Build morale
- Participation
- Crypto compensation?
- Less in the way of politics and turf wars

Alternative to Benevolent Dictator Model

- Can get more done than with Hackathons
- Really really good for nonprofits
- And tech workers between jobs?
- Encourages people to take on roles such as documentation, testing, and bug fixes, which are otherwise not glamorous
- Can also encompass design and market/user discovery


